

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats are required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. ISAF Regulation 20 applies.
- 2.2 Each day, the first, second and third boats in series ranking at the beginning of the day shall display a SOSW bib on the crew. The organizing authority will supply the bibs and instructions for their use.
- 2.3 Unless excused by the Organizing Authority, attendance to daily press conferences and media interviews upon organizer's request is mandatory.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Finn, Laser Men, Laser Radial Men & Women, 470 Men & Women, 49er and RS:X Men & Women classes
- 3.2 Eligible boats and coaches may enter by online registration on the SOSW website (<http://jklabud.hr/sosw>). Confirmed entries will be posted on the event website.
- 3.3 On-Line entries must be received before the end of January 2013 to qualify for the early entry fee.
- 3.4 All competitors and team leaders/coaches shall also complete registration at the Registration Office in JK Labud during registration time (see NoR 5.1). Competitors not so entered will not be eligible for the event, except with prior approval from the OA.
- 3.5 Entry payments during on-site registration will only be accepted in Croatian KUNA. See also NoR 4.2.
- 3.6 Events in which there are fewer than 8 entries by 28. February 2013 may be cancelled. The OA will publish any cancellation notice on the official event website no later than 2. March 2013 and will also notify any entries that have registered their email address.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required non refundable fees are as follows:

- 4.3 Irrespective of NoR 4.1, competitors ranked in the top 10 on the final ISAF 2012 ranking, and Olympic and World medalist in Olympic classes (seniors) who have registered before the end of January will not be required to pay an entry fee.

- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is:

- 5.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, there will be no warning signal for any class after 1.30 PM.

- 5.5 The prize giving ceremony is scheduled for 4.00 PM on Sunday March 17th.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and may be posted on the event website prior to registration.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbor.

- 8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will in accordance with the guidelines for the Olympic Sailing Competition.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the 49er class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(b). Its decisions will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 RRS B8 is deleted.

- 12.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12.4 Classes and categories starting together will be scored and awarded separately at the end of the Regatta by extracting results from the overall ranking. (Categories – Men & Women)

13 SUPPORT BOATS

13.1 Support boats shall register at the race office and shall, at all times while on the water, either fly an identification flag or be marked with a sticker as provided by the OA.

13.2 Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

13.2 During any starting sequence, support boats shall stay at least 50 meters below the starting line and its extensions.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Split Olympic Sailing Week: There will prizes for the the top 3 sailors (crews) in each class.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500.000 € per incident or the equivalent.

18 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENES

By participating in the Split Olympic Sailing Week regatta a competitor automatically grants the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the regatta, the right to, in perpetuity, make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the competitor and its material, during the period he/she participates in the competition Split Olympic Sailing Week without any compensation.

19 ACCOMMODATION

19.1 Detailed information will be available through the event website.

19.2 Sailors who have completed on-line registration before the end of January 2013 and who are either: Top 10 on the final ISAF 2012 Ranking list for Olympic Classes or Medalists at the Olympic Sailing Competition will be provided free accommodation at a 3 stars Hotel, or better. (See also NoR 4.3)
