10TH EDITION SPLIT OLYMPIC SAILING WEEK – SEVENTY SAILORS FROM 12 COUNTRIES SAIL

Homeland sailors took all the prizes

The tenth anniversary edition of Split Olympic Sailing Week ended with sixth race sailed on Wednesday with strong north-east wind, and all first places in four classes, rather inhospitable took Croatian sailors.

And the last day of the sailing fleet of seventy, as helmsmen as crew, awaited the release of the sea. It was planned start time in 11 am, but north-east Bura blowed so strong, with gusts over 30 knots. Therefore, the race committee, with Alen Kustić headed, waited for the wind "blow out" and the start of the last race was given after 13h. The

race area was placed in front of Čiovo, with Bura intensity of 15 to 20 knots, and the gusts on the counter over 25 knots

On the sixth race, we can say, nothing has changed in the order.

So Tonči Stipanović didn't went out on the race field, having already four first places and enough points for insure leading position, so he decided to stay in the sailor's hangar.

- Tomorrow we travel to Hyeres in the last race of the World Cup, so coach Jozo Jakelić and I agreed that it will be better today to finish packing. I'm satisfied with my performance on SOSW, they were excellent condi-

tions for sailing - recapitulates Stipanović.

The satisfaction, especially for good organization and the regatta expressed their guests – second-placed Pole Kacper Zieminski, and third-placed Italian Allesio Spadoni.

On the last day on the sea still went out Tina Mihelić, leading Laser Radial fleet. The current world champion celebrated in last race, while in her stern looked some younger helmsmen - Toma Stipanović from SC Mornar and Todor Tušup from JK Jugole Grakalić.

For the end of this five-day sailing and friendship, the hosts of the regatta Split's YC Labud invited everyone to a new release SOSW next year, as well as an invitation for the European Championship in Finn 2015th which also organizes YC Labud.
